New York Upstate Regional Sunfish Championship June 26-27, 2010

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 ISAF *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Boats must be in compliance with the International Sunfish Class Association *Class Rules*. Boats are subject to measurement at any time during the regatta.
- 1.3 Changes to the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, if any, will appear in the *sailing instructions*.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all members of the Sunfish Class Association. Each skipper must be a member of the Sunfish Class Association. Proof of membership will be required at time of registration. Skippers may join the USSCA at time of registration.
- 2.2 All skippers must fill out a registration form available prior to or during the registration period and submit it along with the required fee.

3 Fees

- 3.1 A registration fee of \$50 is payable at time of registration. A \$5 discount will apply to any registrant who presents a valid ISAF membership card. The fee may be paid in cash or check. Checks should be made out to the Rochester Canoe Club.
- 3.2 The registration fee will entitle a skipper to race and to all five meals. Additional dinners for Saturday evening may be purchased separately for guests.

4 Worlds

The top sailor in the regatta, not already qualified, will be invited to the 2011 World Championship.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at time of registration. Any questions that participants have about the *sailing instructions* can be asked and will be answered during the skippers meeting.

6 Schedule

10:00 First warning signal (races back to back)
12:00 (aprox.) Lunch served at RCC
1:30 First warning after lunch (races back to back)
4:00 No races to begin after this time
6:00 Dinner at RCC

Sunday:

8:00 Breakfast
9:00 First warning signal
12:00 No race to begin after this time
1:30 Pick up lunch and awards at RCC

7 Courses

The courses will be on Irondequoit bay. The actual courses will be defined in the sailing instructions, but will likely be a combination of: Windward-leeward, Triangle, and Olympic courses.

8 Scoring

8.1 This regatta will be scored by Low Point scoring as defined per RSS A4

8.2 When more then 6 races are completed a skipper's worst race will be thrown out

8.3 One (1) race will constitute a regatta.

9 Disclaimer and Liability

All competitors in the regatta are participating at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Rochester Canoe Club is not responsible for any damages or personal injury that should occur before, during, after, or because of this regatta. It is the Canoe Club's policy that all racers will be required to have and wear a USGC approved life jacket at all times when racing.

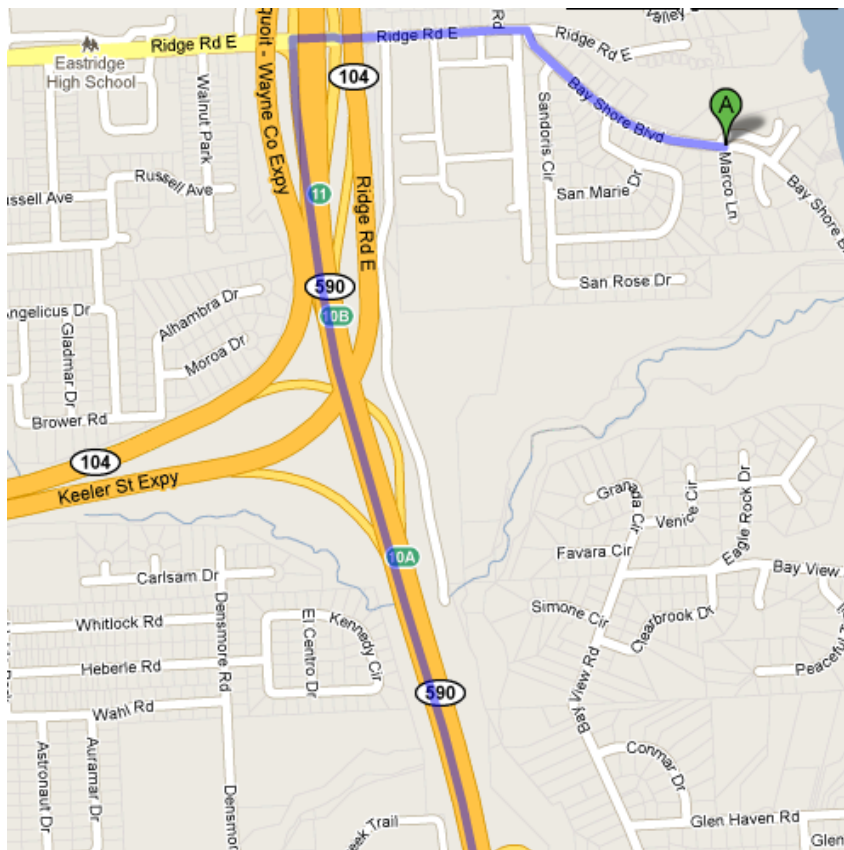
Directions to RCC

The Rochester Canoe Club is located on the west side of Irondequoit Bay, North east of Rochester.

The street address to RCC is 2050 Bayshore Blvd., Rochester, NY, 14622

Driveway: 43°12'10"N, 77°32'18"W Beach: 43°12'15"N, 77°32' 10"W

- Take I-590 north to Ridge Rd exit 11.
- Turn right (east) onto Ridge Rd and go 0.2 miles to Bay Shore Blvd.
- Turn right and go 0.3 miles to the entrance to RCC on the left.
- Go down the steep driveway. This is a one lane driveway, with two pull-overs for cars to pass. Drivers not pulling trailers should yield to drivers with trailers. Otherwise it is generally RCC's custom that up has right-of-way over down.
